Laura Fitzgerald's satirical artworks navigate the complexities of being an artist in a changing world. Drawing inspiration from rural landscapes and ancestral memory, she uses humor as a coping mechanism. Through drawings, paintings, texts, and videos, she provokes thought and introspection, revealing the dance between humor and the struggles of everyday life.

Evelyn Loschy explores the deconstruction of realities through various mediums. Through video, photography, kinetic sculptures, and drawings, Loschy captivates viewers and sparks introspection. Her artworks become emotional resonance spaces, evoking hidden sensations, and questioning the boundaries of self and uniqueness. Destruction and self-destruction play a central role in her oeuvre.

Viktors Svikis presents direct portrayals of strength, power, and violence in everyday settings with the finesse of an old master who uses pop-cultural language and paints collage-like everyday situations with varied and sometimes confusing themes. Svikis amalgamates alienating motifs and realities with subversive humor. Without judging, he tries to analyze what moves humanity.
